

# ETF & Mutual Fund Rankings: Large Cap Blend Style

The Large Cap Blend style ranks third out of the twelve fund styles as detailed in our <u>2Q22 Style Ratings for</u> <u>ETFs and Mutual Funds</u> report. <u>Last quarter</u>, the Large Cap Blend style ranked third as well. The category receives our Attractive rating, which is based on an aggregation of ratings of 121 ETFs and 645 mutual funds in the Large Cap Blend style as of April 14, 2022. Figures 1 and 2 show the five best and worst rated ETFs and mutual funds in the style. Not all Large Cap Blend style ETFs and mutual funds are created the same. The number of holdings varies widely (from 14 to 1,571). This variation creates drastically different investment implications and, therefore, ratings.

Steward Large Cap Core Fund (SJCIX) is excluded from Figure 2 because its total net assets (TNA) are below \$100 million and do not meet our liquidity minimums.

Davis Select U.S. Equity ETF (DUSA) is the top-rated Large Cap Blend ETF and Columbia Disciplined Core Fund (CCQYX) is the top-rated Large Cap Blend mutual fund. Both earn a Very Attractive rating.

Roundhill Meme ETF (MEME) is the worst rated Large Cap Blend ETF and Bull ProFund (BLPSX) is the worst rated Large Cap Blend mutual fund. Both earn a Very Unattractive rating.

#### The Danger Within

Buying a fund without analyzing its holdings is like buying a stock without analyzing its business and finances. Put another way, research on fund holdings is necessary due diligence because a fund's performance is only as good as its holdings' performance. 
### PERFORMANCE OF HOLDINGs = PERFORMANCE OF FUND


### Figure 3: Separating the Best ETFs from the Worst Funds
